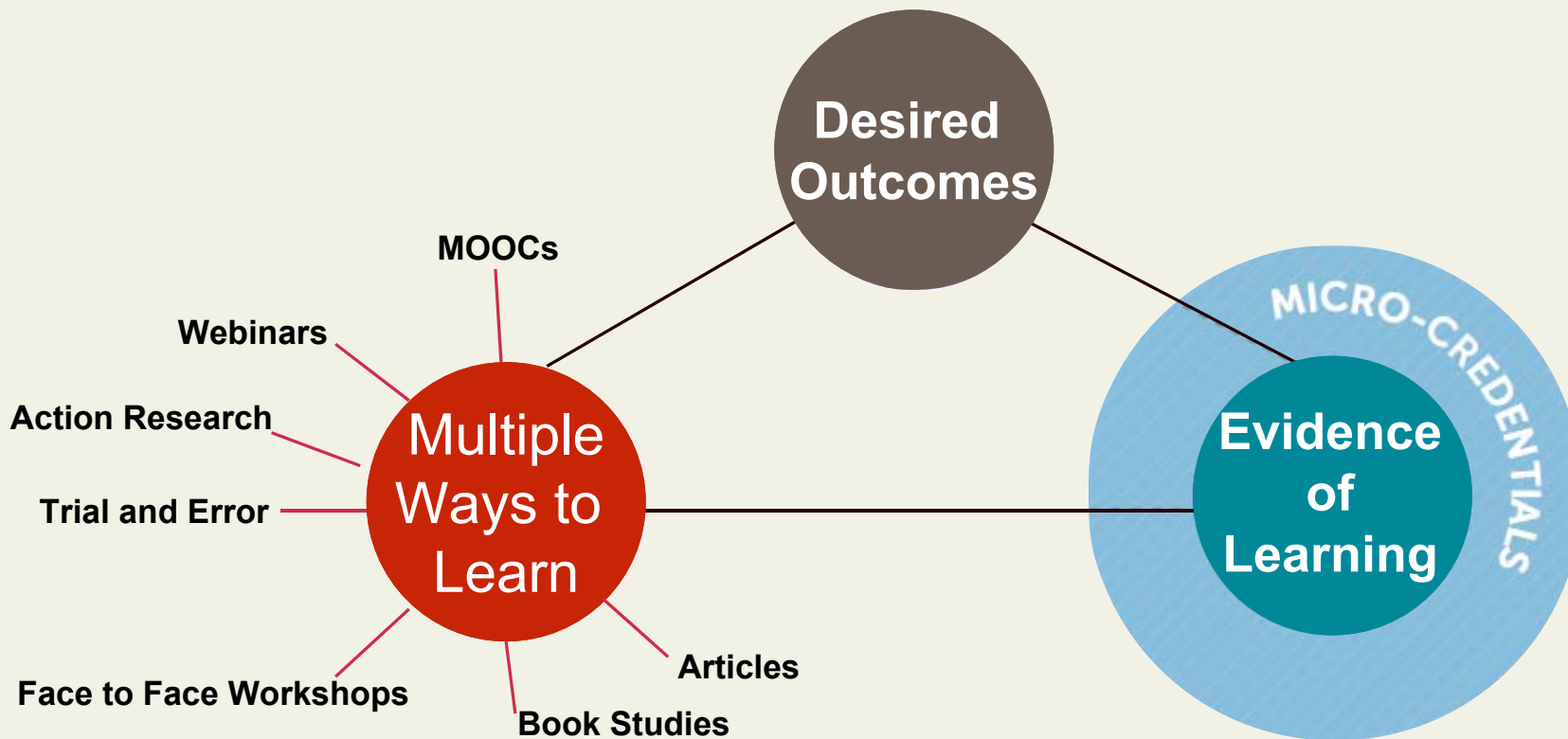


Competency-based System

A system of micro-credentials

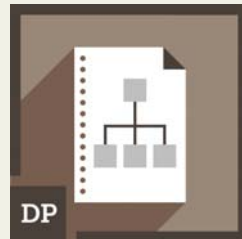
clearly articulates competencies that are important and align with district vision

...can be displayed as DIGITAL BADGES.



- **Specific**
Support interests, goals and immediate needs
- **Transparent**
Include data about the issuer, the earner, and the evidence.
- **Stackable**
Can be combined to create greater meaning and coherence
- **Portable and shareable**
Can be shared by the earner wherever, whenever and with whoever they prefer

 - ✓ Assessments Of Knowledge (AOK)
